<u>Sustainable Travel</u>

The school council is also looking to improve the local environment by encouraging different methods of travel to school and helping to promote kindness and respect around school. We have signed up for 'Sustran's Big Walk and Wheel Challenge' which aims to inspire pupils to make active journeys to school, improve air quality in their neighbourhood and discover how these changes benefit their world. This initiative will take place from $11^{th}-22^{nd}$ of March. More details will be provided closer to the date.

Secondly, we will soon be sending out a parking promise which aims to promote respectful parking in the local community and encourage families to park a little further away from school to reduce the congestion on Firfield Avenue. In exchange for signing the pledge families will receive a car sticker to promote the scheme.
