The United Kingdom	The union of: <b>England, Northern Ireland, Wales, Scotland</b>
The British Isles	The <b>group of islands</b> , located in north-western Europe, that include <b>Britain</b> , and <b>Ireland</b> and <b>over six thousand smaller islands</b>
Island	A piece of <b>land surrounded entirely by water</b>
Loch	A Scottish name for a <b>large lake</b>
Munro	A Scottish name for a <b>mountain</b>
Valley	<b>Sloping land in between two hills or mountains.</b> Valleys often have a river running through them
Coast	An area where <b>land meets the sea.</b> Along the coastline, at the edge of land, you could find stony or sandy beaches and cliffs.
Inhabited	A place that has <b>people living in it</b>
Uninhabited	A place that has <b>no people living in it</b>
