
#### Swimming at Firfield

A reminder the school has three safeguarding leads in school. Mr Yellop, Miss Tittershill and Mr Thurgood. ## Morning Drop Off

Can we remind parents that if you bring your child into school in the morning for registration, if you need to take your child for a medical appointment they must be collected and signed out at the school office and not from the classroom. This is vital so that we are aware of who is on the school site for fire and safeguarding reasons.

## Attendance

Excellent attendance is vital to support pupil learning and development of a detailed schema of rich knowledge across the curriculum. The school's attendance has been in the top 25% for many years. If your child's attendance drops below 90% then Mr Thurgood, our attendance lead will contact parents to see how we can help make improvements.
