Travel and Parking

The Parish Council and the school have received numerous complaints from parents and local residents in regard to parking and travel at drop off and pick up times. This includes inconsiderate parking, causing congestion on Firfield Avenue, dangerous driving and rude and aggressive behaviour towards local residents. I understand that the Parish Council have written to Derbyshire County Council and the local MP to try and come up with some solutions.

We have written to parents on numerous occasions when we have received complaints or concerns for pupil safety including parents using the school car park at WRAP club times. We therefore remind parents to be polite and courteous at all times (these are two of our school values). Please allow more time for your journey to school and try to avoid parking on Firfield Avenue (please leave these spaces for families with adults or pupils who need them for accessibility reasons).

Road Crossing Patrol

As you may be aware there has not been a crossing patrol on Wilsthorpe road for a few months. The responsibility for recruiting Crossing Patrol staff is with Derbyshire County Council transport department and not with the school. We ask parents and pupils to take extra care when crossing this road.
