ADMISSION ARRANGEMENTS & APPLICATION FORMS

The WRAP Club criteria is:

1. Children of staff
2. Children already attending requiring extra sessions
3. Siblings of children already at WRAP club who are starting school
4. Children who have applied and are already on the waiting list (in order of length of time)
5. Children with an EHCP, in care (or have been in care) or SEND;
6. All other applications in order of receipt.

Due to the popularity of the club, it is advised that existing childcare arrangements are not cancelled until confirmation is received that you have been allocated a place.

Application forms are available from the school office. Please call into school to collect one or call on 01332 872216 if you would like to apply.

Should a place not be available, there is a waiting list. Alternatively, we can offer the occasional ad hoc place although please note that ad hoc places are not guaranteed.

INTRODUCTION

Welcome to the Breakfast and After School Clubs' information leaflet which we hope you will find useful and informative.

WRAP Club

Firfield Primary School started its Breakfast Club in November 2008 and following the success of the club, we took over the running of the After School Club in September 2014. As such, we thought it would be a great idea to combine the two clubs and rename them. So, we would like to introduce our WRAP Club.

This fits in with the school's aims to provide extended services that offer wraparound care for children and a convenient service for parents.

The clubs aim to offer:-

- a safe, nurturing environment for children before and after the school day giving them the opportunity chat to their friends and play;
- alternative provision for your children at affordable prices;
- help with homework and other curriculum based activities if required; and
- provide breakfast/snack to those children attending.

The clubs are very popular and we are full most days. Because of its popularity, we have had to cap the daily numbers that attend the clubs to 60 for Breakfast Club and After School Club.

ACTIVITIES & THEMED DAYS

WRAP Club likes to run in conjunction with the school's planned activities and themes. As such, the children do participate in a range of activities such as making vegetable animals for Harvest Festival, Christmas activities (sometimes linked to events occurring in the local Church), making cards for Easter, teddy bear's picnic, food tasting for European Day of Languages, berry themed meals, etc.

The clubs also offer a range of activities both inside and outside including football, tennis, cricket, trim trail, colouring, lego, games, use of the ICT suite, to name but a few. However, we are always open to new ideas, so suggestions are appreciated.

TIMINGS

Breakfast Club

The Breakfast Club runs from 7.30am until 8.50am when children are taken out on to the playground ready to line up.

After School Club

The After School Club starts at 3.30pm and continues until 6.00pm every day.



FOOD PROVISION

The children receive a choice of breakfast at the morning club and we provide a light tea for those attending the After School Club. During winter, we offer hot food for both clubs e.g. porridge, beans on toast, soup and pasta. Please note that the food provided at the After School Club is not a full meal and is not meant to replace your family evening meal.
